

Welcome to the EFiX Booting Center for EFiX V1.1

Timer

In order to make Booting process automatic we implemented a special 5 seconds timer.

After the time countdown to 0 - your latest booted OS will be boot by auto, or will boot default HDD in case if you did never boot your EFiX before.

Booting memory

EFiX Booting Center does remember your latest choice and after reboot will automatically offer you to boot from your latest booted selection.

EFiX does memorise any bootable media except DVD-Rom.

Extended Mac OS X 10.6 (Snow Leopard) support

Your EFiX can now switch between 32 Bit and 64 Bit modes

Shortcuts and functions of new EFiX Booting Center

In order to use any of following functions please stop the timer with any key (best is to use Arrow-keys for this)

F6 - change between 32 Bit and 64 Bit for Mac OS X 10.6 (Snow Leopard)

How to use this function:

1. Boot in to the EFiX Booting Center
 2. Press any key to stop the timer
 3. Select Mac OS X 10.6 HDD and Press "F6"- key
- (you can press "F6" to switch between 32 Bit and 64 Bit)

EFiX will remember your last choice

4. Press "Enter" in order to boot from HDD

s - boot Mac OS X 10.5 / 10.6 in verbose mode

How to use this function:

1. Boot in to the EFiX Booting Center

2. Press any key to stop the timer

3. Select Mac OS X 10.5 / 10.6 (HDD, DVD etc.) and Press "s"- key

(This function is not memorised by EFiX, so by next reboot it will boot without verbose mode,

except you do activate this function manually again)

4. Press "Enter" in order to boot from HDD

Hidden Functions and Tricks:

F6-key does work not for HDD only, but also for Installation DVD of Mac OS X 10.6 (Snow Leopard) too.

Due this function does not have any indication you can see the result only while the icon for Mac OS X 10.6 will change while booting from DVD icon to Snow Leopard ICON.

Please pay attention that this function for Mac OS X 10.6 exist on EFiX only.

How to use this function:

1. Turn on your PC

2. Put genuine Mac OS X 10.6 Installation DVD in your DVD-ROM

3. Reboot your machine (ex. Reset button)

4. Boot in to the EFiX Booting Center

5. Press any key to stop the timer

6. Select DVD-Rom and Press "F6"- key

7. Press "Enter" in order to boot from DVD

While Booting the Icon will change from DVD into Mac OS X
10.6 icon.
